Shaykh Umer Khan completed his formal Shahādah al-‘Ālimiyyah degree (License in Islamic Scholarship, i.e. ‘ālim program) from Al-Salam Institute, authorized by Dar al-‘Ulūm Nadwat al-‘Ulamā’, Lucknow, India. He also completed a traditional Dars-e-Nizāmī dawrah of the six canonical books of ḥadīth. Shaykh Umer completed his iftā’ (License to Give Islāmīc Legal Verdicts) from Darulifta Birmingham, granting him the traditional title of ‘mufti’. He has a Master’s in Finance (from Wharton, UPenn) and another Master’s in Islamic Finance and he holds several professional certifications and qualifications in Islamic Finance. Shaykh Umer teaches the Islamic sciences at seminaries (Institute of Knowledge, Al-Salam Institute, and Critical Loyalty), researches and writes fatwās (legal verdicts) for various institutions, and serves as a sharī‘ah advisor to a number of companies.
